

How to Locate Credible Databases and Research Sources

Using credible sources in your research is important. It reflects well on your scholarship, and it makes you more credible in the eyes of your audiences.

Generally, academic journals and [nurs fpx 4010 assessment 4 stakeholder presentation](#) published by university presses are considered reliable. Other trustworthy sources include websites operated by educational or government institutions (.edu,.gov), and Google Scholar.

Stakeholder Presentation

Stakeholders are individuals or organisations who rely on the outcome of a business. They have a vested interest in the organisation or its outcome, and are generally internal (customers, management staff) or external (investors). Managing stakeholders requires group decision-making and collective action across divisions. It's a trust-based partnership, so building and maintaining strong, meaningful relationships is key to stakeholder success.

A well-designed presentation is [NURS FPX 4050 Assessment 2 Ethical and Policy Factors in Care](#) of the tools a manager can use to make their next stakeholder engagement a success. Stakeholder presentations should include a clear agenda and goals, as well as an opportunity for feedback and debriefing. This slide deck features a range of stunning slides covering various aspects of stakeholder management. It also includes a useful graphic that illustrates the 5 steps of stakeholder management.

Ethical and Policy Factors in Care

The role of government policies and their enforcement in healthcare can create many ethical complications and dilemmas. For example, some policies impose the requirement of having insurance on professionals or can lead to the imposition of fines when not followed (Regis College Online, 2021).

Ethical values and morals play a significant role in healthcare as workers must recognize and make decisions while keeping within their code of ethics [nurs fpx 4030 assessment 1 locating credible databases and research](#) laws that govern them. In addition, healthcare workers must understand and communicate the policy issues that affect care coordination. A scholarly communication strategy that involves researching the topic and developing a presentation is an appropriate approach to this NURS FPX 4050 assessment.

Conflict Negotiation

Although the primary goal of conflict negotiation is to create an agreement that benefits all parties, it is important to remember that not everyone will be able to come to an acceptable compromise. In this case, it is important to plan for the worst-case scenario and have a backup strategy in place so that you are prepared to walk away from negotiations at any time.

One way to prepare for this possibility is to brainstorm your alternatives to resolution early on and have a clear "best alternative" in mind when you enter into the conflict resolution process. This will help you stay focused on finding solutions that benefit all parties rather than [FPX 3700 Assessment 4 Conflict Negotiation](#) in horse-trading where the more egregious demands are met and nothing of significance is given up by either party.

During the conflict resolution process, it is also important to separate people from the problem at hand and not respond to personal attacks. Effective communication also includes listening actively to your opponent's concerns and attempting to understand their perspectives through techniques like repeating back critical information, affirming statements and maintaining eye contact.

Scholarly Activities

The definition of scholarship is broad and has been addressed in several academic articles (Boyer, Fincher et al, Simpson et al). Scholarly activities include traditional discipline-based Research (Basic or Applied) and creative works.

The College will promote scholarly activity by encouraging a culture of curiosity and innovation across the campus, community counseling centers, and clinics. To further enhance the applied learning environment and foster collaboration with industry and business, we will [nrs 493 scholarly activities](#) research that supports the mission of each subspecialty. This research will be conducted within the framework of the Research policies and guidelines.

Currently, there are differences in the definition of scholarship for the NURS FPX 493 assessment among Residency Review Committees (RRCs). Some RRCs have adapted a rubric that was developed by Boyer to reduce subjectivity in the evaluation of scholarly activities and to address expectations for core teaching faculty as well as trainees. Other RRCs have created their own rubrics to evaluate scholarly activities and professional participation/performance.
